

Fremont Township Minutes July 10, 2025

The regular meeting for the Fremont Twp. Board of Trustees was held on July 10, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. at the Fremont Township Hall.

Board members present: M. Blatt, A. Prill, R. Curell, C. Franzel and B. Blatt. Absent: None.

MINUTES:

Motion made by B. Blatt seconded by R. Curell to approve the June 12, 2025, regular meeting minutes as presented – motion carried.

BILLS:

Motion to pay the bills as presented made by C. Franzel, seconded by A. Prill - motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: None

CLERK REPORT:

Zoning Report - In June he issued no citations or permits. He did issue a letter to an address on Brown Road regarding blight and has given them until July 14th to cleanup. He also fielded multiple calls and emails. He spoke with a couple people regarding issues that will require Zoning Board of Appeals once applications are submitted. Fire Assessment – A. Prill stated that the notice has been sent to the newspapers for publication and will be in the mail within the week to all property owners for the special meeting to be held on August 14th at 7:30 pm.

TREASURER REPORT:

Treasurer balance as of June 30, 2025, was \$373,830.83. Motion to accept the treasurer's report made by B. Blatt, seconded by R. Curell - motion carried.

SUPERVISOR REPORT:

Cemetery Report – The caretaker was able to get all the storm damaged trees cleaned up as well as the trees damaged at the Township Hall. M. Blatt stated that he would like to thank Zach for getting all this cleanup done in such a timely fashion.

Road Report – M. Blatt stated that the roadside mowing should begin this next week. The mower is a little behind schedule because of all the rain we have been getting.

NEW BUSINESS:

A. Prill stated that H. Wymore wanted to request that the Board approve to pay the Sexton to help them set some headstones that have fallen over. The Sexton said he would charge \$75 per hour and H. Wymore stated that it shouldn't take more than one day to complete. R. Curell asked if the headstones were in the old cemetery and A. Prill stated that she was not sure but they have been working on the historical markers so it should be in the old cemetery. The Board decided to table this until we can get more information.
