

Fremont Township Minutes
June 11, 2026

The regular meeting for the Fremont Twp. Board of Trustees was held on June 11, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at the Fremont Township Hall.

Board members present: M. Blatt, R. Curell, A. Prill, C. Franzel and Brandon Blatt. Absent: None.
Guests: Henry & Carolyn Wymore, Theresa Bristol-Miller, Greg Eggert, Ken Bragg, Jennifer Leitzel, Gail Prill, Jason Root (Road Commission Superintendent), Sally Minehart, and Tyler Ireland.

MINUTES:

Motion made by B. Blatt, seconded by C. Franzel to approve the May 14, 2026, regular meeting minutes as presented - motion carried.

BILLS:

Motion to pay the bills as presented, made by C. Franzel, seconded by R. Curell - motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

It was mentioned that Arland Draper has begun work again on the historical markers at the Fremont Township Cemetery.

CLERK REPORT:

Zoning Report - In May the Zoning Administrator issued two citations and four permits. He is also working on four new complaints and continuing investigations on several other complaints.

Thumb Electric & Fiber Franchise Ordinance – need to approve this ordinance so that it can published in the local newspaper. Motion made to approve the ordinance by B. Blatt, seconded by R. Curell. Roll call vote: C. Franzel-yes, A. Prill-yes, R. Curell-yes, B. Blatt-yes, and M. Blatt-yes. Motion carried.

NFPA 1 - The Clerk asked the board if they all received the email from the Fire Chief regarding NFPA 1 and what their thoughts were on the topic. The Board agreed that we should get more information. M. Blatt stated that other supervisors had talked with him regarding this and that they would also like more information.

Garbage Contract - the Clerk mentioned that the current garbage contract expires in November. M. Blatt stated that we should reach out to Republic and see if they want to extend the current contract and what the cost would be.

TREASURER REPORT:

Treasurer balance as of May 31, 2026, was \$221,062.12. Motion to accept the treasurer's report made by B. Blatt, seconded by R. Curell - motion carried.

The Treasurer mentioned that taking credit card payments is in the works and should be up and running by July 1st. She wondered if the board was ok with her opening up a savings account for those payments to be placed into so that it was easier to keep track of the credit card payments. Motion made by A. Prill, seconded by B. Blatt to approve the Treasurer to open a savings account for the credit card payments and to pull \$50 from the general account for this purpose. Roll call vote: R. Curell-yes, B. Blatt-yes, C. Franzel-yes, A. Prill-yes, and M. Blatt-yes. Motion carried.

The Treasurer also let the Board know that Mayville State Bank said they would not make the 2.5% interest rate. M. Blatt asked C. Franzel to talk with the President of the bank about this and if needed M.

Blatt would call him. If they will not match the 2.5% than we should look at switching banks. R. Curell asked if Frankenmuth Credit Union would still accept tax payments and C. Franzel said that they would.

SUPERVISOR REPORT:

Cemetery Report – Had some trees and branches come down from the storm and the Caretaker is working on cleaning that up.

Road Report – M. Blatt stated that roadside mowing should begin the first week of July. He also stated that Snover Road is fixed and back open. M. Blatt also stated that he attended the Road Commission's Supervisors meeting today and he wished that all township supervisors would have attended to see the presentation from the Highway Engineer. He stated that they are not just planning for projects for next year but they are planning 3-5 years out on projects. M. Blatt stated that the Road Commission is doing a fantastic job and he hopes nothing changes.

NEW BUSINESS:

M. Blatt asked the Planning Commission Chair if they had received the paperwork requested on the last approved special land use meeting. G. Eggert stated that they are still waiting for the paperwork and that the applicant was given 60 days to produce the paperwork.

Motion to adjourn the meeting made by A. Prill, seconded by B. Blatt – motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:28 p.m.
