The regular meeting for the Fremont Twp. Board of Trustees was held on November 8, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. at the Fremont Township Hall.

**MINUTES:**

Motion made by M. Blatt, seconded by J. Welke to approve the October 13, 2018, meeting minutes as presented – motion carried

**BILLS:**

Motion to pay the bills as presented with the addition of a payment to Seven Services for \$176.52 made by H. Wymore, seconded by C. Sherwin – motion carried

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** None.

**CLERK REPORT:**

Poverty Exemption Resolution – The Board needs to approve a Poverty Exemption Resolution. Motion made by H. Wymore, seconded by J. Welke to approve the Poverty Exemption Resolution as previously approved following with the current Federal Poverty Guidelines. Motion made by A. Holbrook, seconded by H. Wymore. Roll call vote: C. Sherwin-yes, A. Holbrook-yes, J. Welke-yes, M. Blatt-yes, and H. Wymore-yes. Motion carried.

**TREASURER REPORT:**

Treasurer balance was \$393,007.20 as of October 31, 2018. Motion to accept treasurer report made by J. Welke, seconded by M. Blatt – motion carried.

**SUPERVISOR REPORT:**

Cemetery Report – Sold \$800 worth of lots in September and had 1 burial in October.

Road Report – not much to report at this time.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Board appointments – H. Wymore recommends that we reappoint Tyler Ireland, Jennifer Leitzel, and Theresa Bristol-Miller to the Board of Review and appoint Greg Eggert as an alternate to the Board of Review for a 2-year term. H. Wymore also recommended that we reappoint Jim Holmes to the Zoning Board of Appeals for a 3-year term, Motion made by H. Wymore, seconded by M. Blatt to approved the recommended Board appointments – motion carried.

Evergreen Creek project – H. Wymore finally received approval from the DEQ so now we can put the project out for bid. J. Welke asked if we have to hire an inspector for the project and H. Wymore stated that the DEQ would inspect the project.

C. Sherwin mentioned that we will be getting a bill from the DEQ because there is a new law in place that if a business has a private well and a drinking fountain for public use that they have to have a license which costs around \$142 and the well will also need to be tested every year at a cost of around \$76.
