

**Fremont Township Minutes**  
**July 14, 2022**

The regular meeting for the Fremont Twp. Board of Trustees was held on July 14, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. at the Fremont Township Hall.

Board members present: A. Holbrook, R. Curell, M. Blatt, C. Franzel, and K. Thom. Absent: None.

Guests: Greg Eggert, Theresa Bristol-Miller, Brandon Blatt, Ken Bragg, Ida Barrons, Gail Prill, and Jennifer Miller.

**MINUTES:**

Motion made by R. Curell, seconded by C. Franzel to approve the June 9, 2022, meeting minutes as presented - motion carried.

**BILLS:**

Motion to pay the bills as presented, made by C. Franzel, seconded by R. Curell - motion carried.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

A Resident wanted to give a compliment on the gravel job done on Waterman Road. Another Resident stated that Chambers Road looks nice also. A Resident questioned as to why the phone bill is so high and why we need a phone at the hall since the Board all has cell phones. C. Franzel stated that she is talking with someone this week regarding the phone bill. Another Resident asked when they were going to do the roadside mowing and M. Blatt stated they will start the last week of July or the first week of August.

**CLERK REPORT:**

A. Holbrook gave the Board the report from the Zoning Administrator. He issued four citations and one permit.

**TREASURER REPORT:**

Treasurer balance as of June 30, 2022, was \$881,310.76. Motion to accept the treasurer report made by A. Holbrook, seconded by R. Curell - motion carried.

**SUPERVISOR REPORT:**

Cemetery Report – No burials this month but do have several cremation burials coming up. Henry Wymore and several volunteers donated their time to stain the bridge at the Fremont Cemetery.

Road Report – Brush spray bid came in at \$12,500.00 and we would qualify for the \$2,500 matching funds.

Motion made by K. Thom, seconded by R. Curell to approve the brush spray bid – motion carried. M. Blatt talked with the Road Commission about Washburn Road and what it would take to fix that road. The Road Commission recommends taking some core samples which would cost \$3,550.00. Motion made by K.

Thom, seconded by A. Holbrook to approve spending \$3,550 for core samples on Washburn Road – motion carried. M. Blatt mentioned that the Road Commission did put gravel on Phelps Lake Road and that should solve the flooding issue for the next ten years.

Meeting adjourned at 7:27 p.m.
