He also mentioned that a lot of people from out of state are purchasing farmland in our area and putting it under the PA260 which caps their taxes if they continue to farm the land. This is something that we need to keep an eye on because it could in turn make our taxes go up. He stated that he is all for keeping farmland as farmland, but we need to make sure that it is done correctly. Vaughan said he would check into this with the County Commissioners.
